# **Strategies for Developing Resiliency**

#### Balance optimism and realism

 Resiliency requires seeing things as they are, good or bad, and imagining the possibilities for how they can be in the future.

#### Pay attention to relationships

 Be a good boss, a good colleague, a good friend, a good listener and a good supporter of people's best selves. It will come back to you.

#### Think positively

 Bad things happen to good people. Learn to see those difficult situations as opportunities. "In the middle of difficulty lies opportunity."

#### Learn and move on

 One bad or difficult situation is not a judgement of your entire professional life.

- Reflect on performance
- Explore new techniques
- Set personal goals
- Adapt
